## 2024/25 Conditioning Camp and Evaluation Information

We look forward to welcoming you all back in only **5 more days!** As I hope you have read through our communications thus far, our annual conditioning camp and evaluation process begins on Tuesday September 3<sup>rd</sup> and will run through until final team selections on Sunday September 22<sup>nd</sup>. Here are the pertinent updates for you today:

### Conditioning Camp Groupings

The conditioning camp groups have been established based on current registrations. As previously communicated, your player will remain in this group for the first five ice sessions (4 conditioning camp groups and skills evaluation). A couple important notes:

- 1) If your player is not on the listing, please contact us ASAP!
- 2) Don't spend any time reading into the groupings... they are assigned alphabetically.
- 3) Please don't request to be moved from groups. We understand that there are some early ice times and some late ice times. Unfortunately that is the nature of the ice availability and it is only for a few ice times until teams are established.
- 4) For conditioning camp, your player does not need to "sign in" when they arrive. This changes once evaluations begin.
- 5) The Evaluations webpage has the most upto date information on evaluations. Please note that the ice times on Sunday September 22<sup>nd</sup> have been moved later in the day (than what was previously communicated) due to a request from the facility.
- 6) U11 goaltenders are welcome to join in on all of the conditioning camp opportunities to get in a skate. As you will note by the calendar of dates, goaltender skills evaluations are separate.
